Amendments to the Examination By-Laws Applicable for All Academic Programs of the Faculty of Allied Health Sciences

The amendments relate to Clause 17 applicable to all four degree programmes under Ref. FAHS-FB-56; and Clause 20.3(v) of Ref. FAHS-FB-56.

Current Clause	Proposed Amendment
<p><u>Clause 17</u> The candidate who obtains a grade less than C shall have to repeat the relevant subject/s or course unit/s in the subsequent examination in order to improve the grade. However, only three (03) subsequent attempts shall be permitted to do so within the maximum number of years permitted to complete the degree course.</p>	<p>A candidate who receives a grade below 'C' must repeat the relevant subject(s) or course unit(s) to improve the grade within the maximum period allowed for completion of the degree programme. <i>Effective from existing batches (2020/2021, 2021/2022, 2022/2023, 2023/2024) and onwards.</i></p>
<p><u>Clause 20.3 (v)</u> A repeat examination will be held only for Part I and Part IV year end examinations, not less than 6 weeks after the date of releasing the result of the previous examination.</p>	<p>A repeat examination will be held only for Part IV year end examinations, not less than 6 weeks after the date of releasing the result of the main examination. <i>Effective from 2024/2025 batch onwards.</i></p>
